With design and marketing by fellow directors Neil Worthington and John Stevenson, also long-term enthusiasts and previous owners of VW campervans, Volksleisure conversions have the classic side kitchen layout, with a Reimo elevating roof and seating for five, plus plenty of style and luxury with a choice of interiors, LED mood lighting, heating, mains hook-up and more. For extra versatility, the rear seat slides on a rail system to offer lots of living space when camping, or extra luggage space while travelling.

There's a choice of 102 PS or 140 PS 2.0 TDI engines, with prices from £41,000 and £43,000 respectively. Options include alloys, leather upholstery, Thule awning, LED awning lighting, and rear parking sensors, Bluetooth connectivity and a solar panel.
