

# Trio High-Style

This campervan may boast plenty of style but it's also practical, with a Reimo sliding seat system to accommodate bulky gear or up to seven passengers...



**T**he new Trio High-Style is a joint venture between Volksleisure and Westward Leisure, and the result is a VW T6-based campervan that's Reimo approved and features its Variotech 3000 seat and power rail system, and elevating roof.

The Reimo bench/bed is one of the best around and it's very practical, having three seatbelts. As it's fitted to a track system on the floor, the bench can be locked into multiple positions to allow passengers to sit near to the cab and to increase boot space to be able to load bikes, for example. If needed, a further two travel seats can also be added, making it a seven-seater. Come bedtime, the Variotech 3000 easily converts

to a good-sized double bed (1.92m by 1.20m) while the roof bed (1.90m by 1.10m) provides a further two berths.

With a side kitchen layout, you get a 39-litre Wæeco compressor fridge with a five-litre freezer compartment. Next to this is a cupboard with an aluminium roll-down door for storing the chemical loo. Above the fridge is where you'll find the sink, which features a tap that doubles as an external shower – pull it out to extend the hose and use it through the kitchen window to wash down wetsuits or muddy dogs. The sink also benefits from a nifty cover that folds forwards to create extra workspace when cooking or making tea. Next to the sink there's a two-burner gas hob, for which

there is room for two cylinders at the back of the 'van, as well as two 13-litre fresh water containers, although there's the option of a 30-litre underslung water tank, if preferred.

The furniture is all high-gloss with soft-close drawers, and lighting consists of an LED strip above the kitchen, and another along the front of the kitchen unit, as well as numerous spotlights around the 'van. There are also two lollipop style reading lights at the front, which are especially handy for those sleeping in the roof bed – no more fumbling around in the dark with a torch! There's a cluster of 12V, 230V and USB sockets to the side of the kitchen/side of the wardrobe, where you'll also find the controls for the Webasto heating.



The base vehicle is the SWB 148bhp (150PS) engine model with a six-speed manual gearbox, and there's the option (for £2,000) to specify the DSG automatic version, and/or a long-wheelbase vehicle (£1,800), if you prefer.

## The Volksleisure & Westward Leisure lowdown

Volksleisure and Westward Leisure have teamed up to build the Reimo Trio High-Style, which they claim is the flagship of campervans designed by Reimo.

This campervan duo are authorised Reimo agents and all their Reimo campervans are built in their Reimo dedicated workshop

in north Devon.

They mainly use the VW T30 van with VW factory-fitted swivel seats and in Highline specification. They can also build on a Transporter panel van and fit their own glass windows, or on the Combi with VW factory glass. Customers have a range of interior finishes to choose from and there are many additional extras you can add in order to personalise your camper.

If you'd like to see the Trio High-Style in the flesh, Volksleisure and Westward Leisure have showrooms in Bradford (West Yorkshire) for the north, and Bideford (north Devon) for the south of the country.
